Subsequently Ms. Liu Mao conducted field investigation for the proposed project and recommended rescue excavation for certain project areas in 2001. AMO conducted survey for the road entrance in November 2005. Rescue excavation programme for road project was reported to Members vide AAB Board Paper AAB/65/2005-06 and AAB/78/2005-06.	Field Archaeology Unit of AMO	Prehistoric stone implements and pottery sherds were yielded from stable cultural deposits. The excavation was completed in end of Mar 07.
Former Mountain Lodge (舊港督山頂別墅)	Archaeological investigation from end Jan to Mar 07 (two months)	Peak Tourism District Enhancement Programme	The building was built in 1902 and demolished in 1946. For further details please refer to Board Paper AAB/9/2007-08.	Field Archaeology Unit of AMO	Field investigation was completed in end of Mar 07.
Former Police Married Quarters Site at Hollywood Road (荷李活道已婚警察宿舍前址)	Archaeological investigation (late Mar to Jun 07)	Redevelopment Project	The site of the Former Hollywood Road Police Married Quarters previously housed the Central College, which was demolished in 1948 to make way for the Police Married Quarters. Boundary walls of the College surrounding the Site are still preserved in-situ. Please refer to Board Paper AAB/52/2005-06.
