1.	Ho Chung, Sai Kung (西貢蠔涌)	Archaeological Survey in mid January 2008 (a week)	Small House Development	The site was first discovered by the Second Territory-wide Survey in 1997. Rescue excavation for the road projects recovered significant prehistoric cultural remains and ceramics of Song dynasty in 1999. Further survey conducted by Mr. Mo Zhi in 2001 yielded some prehistoric pottery and stone objects.	Field Archaeology Unit of AMO	No cultural remains were recovered from test pits of the proposed village house site.
2.	Sha Po Old Village, Lamma Island (南丫島沙埔舊村)	Archaeological Survey in late January 2008 (a week)	Small House Development	The site was first recorded in 1930s. Several investigations were conducted by Hong Kong Archaeological Society from 1970s to 1990s.	Field Archaeology Unit of AMO	Sparse cultural remains were found from test pits of the proposed village house site.
