# MEMORANDUM FOR MEMBERS OF THE <u>ANTIQUITIES ADVISORY BOARD</u>

# ASSESSMENT OF 1,444 HISTORIC BUILDINGS FINALISATION OF THE GRADINGS <u>OF PROPOSED GRADED BUILDINGS</u>

### PURPOSE

This paper requests Members to consider endorsing the gradings of the items as detailed in paragraphs 2 to 3 below.

### BACKGROUND

2. Up to the present, Members have endorsed the gradings of 602 historic buildings including -

- (a) 118 Grade 1 buildings;
- (b) 230 Grade 2 buildings; and
- (c) 254 Grade 3 buildings

At the meeting on 24 June 2010, Members will proceed to consider the gradings of the remaining 46 buildings as listed in Annex B and Annex C to the Board Paper AAB/40/2009-10.

#### MORE ITEMS FOR CONSIDERATION

3. In addition to those listed in the aforementioned paper, there are 103 other buildings for which notification letters have successfully reached the owners and no adverse comment has been received by the Antiquities and Momuments Office. They are set out at <u>Annex A</u>. There are also 3 items at <u>Annex B</u> with queries already settled and 7 items at <u>Annex C</u> with requests for combining their gradings.
