2.	Yuen Shan, Kam Tin, Yuen Long (元朗錦田園山)	Archaeological Survey in early August 2010 (1 week)	Village Small House Development	The site was first recorded in 2001. Surface collection included few ceramic sherds of Han and Ming dynasties.	Field Archaeology Unit of AMO	No cultural remains were recovered from test pits of the proposed small house sites.

Ho Pui, Yuen Long (元朗河背)	Archaeological Survey in mid August 2010 (1 week)	Small House Development	The West Rail Environmental Impact Assessment Study first recorded that prehistoric pottery sherds were discovered at the site in 1999.
