Archaeological survey for small house development in Hong Mei Tsuen, Yuen Long (元朗巷尾村)	An archaeological survey to examine the archaeological potential of the small house site within the Tung Tau Tsuen Site of Archaeological Interest.	The survey was completed in June 2012. No cultural remain was recovered from test pits of the small house site.
2.	Archaeological survey for small house development on Cheung Chau (長洲)	An archaeological survey to examine the archaeological potential of the small house site within the Tung Wan Site of Archaeological Interest, Cheung Chau.	The survey was completed in September 2012. No significant cultural remain was recovered from test pits of the small house site.
3.	Archaeological survey for small house development in Ho Chung, Sai Kung (西貢蠔涌)	An archaeological survey to examine the archaeological potential of the small house site within the Ho Chung Site of Archaeological Interest.	The survey was completed in October 2012. No cultural remain was recovered from test pits of the small house site.
4.	Archaeological survey for small house development in Lung Kwu Tan, Tuen Mun (屯門龍鼓灘)	An archaeological survey cum excavation in the small house site within the Lung Kwu Tan Site of Archaeological Interest.	The excavation was completed in October 2012. Pottery sherds from mid-Neolithic period were unearthed from the small house site. Post-excavation processing is underway.

5.	Archaeological survey for small house developments in Sha Ha, Sai Kung (西貢沙下)	An archaeological survey to examine the archaeological potential of the small house site within the Sha Ha Site of Archaeological Interest.	The survey was completed in November 2012. Kiln furniture fragments and sparse ceramic sherds dated to Tang and Song dynasties were unearthed from test pits of the small house sites. Post-excavation processing is underway.
