# MEMORANDUM FOR MEMBERS OF THE ANTIQUITIES ADVISORY BOARD

## REVISED CONCEPT DESIGN FOR INTERPRETATION OF THE FORMER MOUNTAIN LODGE AND IMPROVEMENT TO ITS SURROUNDING AREAS

#### **PURPOSE**

This paper seeks Members' advice on the revised concept design for the interpretation of the Former Mountain Lodge (FML) and improvement to its surrounding areas.

#### **BACKGROUND**

2. On 20 February 2013, the Architectural Services Department (ArchSD) presented a concept design for interpretation of the FML and improvement to its surrounding areas to Members vide Board Paper AAB/3/2013-14 at **Appendix A**. With Members' invaluable advice, ArchSD has revised the concept design with inputs from the Central and Western District Leisure Services Office and the Antiquities and Monuments Office of the Leisure and Cultural Services Department (LCSD) as well as the Commissioner for Heritage's Office of the Development Bureau.

#### REVISED CONCEPT DESIGN

3. The revised concept design for interpretation of the FML and improvement to its surrounding areas is at <u>Appendix B</u>. It will be further refined with reference to Members' comments. The Central and Western District Council will then be consulted. Upon finalisation of the concept design, LCSD will work with ArchSD and other departments concerned to

implement the proposal.
