1.	Archaeological survey for small house development at Ho Chung, Sai Kung (西貢蠔涌)	An archaeological survey to examine the archaeological potential of the small house site within the Ho Chung Site of Archaeological Interest.	The survey was completed in mid-October 2014. No significant cultural remain was recovered from the test pits of the small house site.
2.	Archaeological survey for village house redevelopment at Tung Wan, Cheung Chau (長洲東灣)	An archaeological survey to examine the archaeological potential of the village house site within the Tung Wan Site of Archaeological Interest, Cheung Chau.	Fieldwork commenced in mid-October 2014. With the discovery of prehistoric cultural remains, the excavation area was extended. Excavation was completed in mid-November 2014. Cultural remains such as painted pottery sherds from the middle Neolithic period and bronze hook from the Bronze Age were unearthed.
