Fieldwork was conducted in mid-November 2016. One pottery sherd dated to Han dynasty was unearthed from the village house site.
2.	Archaeological survey for small house development at Lung Kwu Tan, Tuen Mun	An archaeological survey to examine the archaeological potential of a village house site located within Lung Kwu Tan Site of Archaeological Interest in Tuen Mun.	Fieldwork was conducted between mid-November and mid-December 2016. Pottery sherds and broken stone implements of prehistoric period were unearthed from the small house site.
3.	Archaeological survey for small house development at Lo So Shing, Lamma Island	An archaeological survey to examine the archaeological potential of three village house sites located within Lo So Shing Site of Archaeological Interest on Lamma Island.	Fieldwork is in progress.
