1.	Archaeological survey for small house development at Sha Tau Kok San Tsuen in North District	An archaeological survey to examine the archaeological potential of a village house site located within the Sha Tau Kok San Tsuen Site of Archaeological Interest in North District.	Fieldwork was conducted in mid-July 2020. No significant artefact was found during the archaeological survey.
2.	Archaeological survey for small house development at Lo So Shing on Lamma Island	An archaeological survey to further examine the archaeological potential of a village house site located within the Lo So Shing Site of Archaeological Interest on Lamma Island.	Fieldwork was first undertaken in 2016 and was further conducted from mid-July to late July 2020. Archaeological remains of pottery sherds and stone implements from pre-historic period as well as fragments of kiln furniture with fired clay from Tang dynasty were found in the excavation.
