Tai Fu Tai Mansion, Old House of Wong Uk Village and Fortified Structure in Ha Pak Nai were closed from 29 January to 5 May 2020, re-opened from 6 May to 14 July 2020, and closed again from 15 July 2020 to 13 September 2020.
