

**Antiquities and Monuments Office's Comments  
On the Heritage Impact Assessment in respect of  
Site Formation and Infrastructure Works for Public Housing Development  
at A Kung Ngam Village, Eastern – Investigation, Design and Construction**

The Antiquities and Monuments Office (“AMO”) has reviewed the findings set out in the Heritage Impact Assessment (“HIA”) report in respect of Site Formation and Infrastructure Works for Public Housing Development at A Kung Ngam Village, Eastern – Investigation, Design and Construction, and has the following comments:

- (a) It is noted that through appropriate measures, site clearance and infrastructure works will be provided for the future public housing development at A Kung Ngam Village. The proposal, is agreeable from the heritage conservation perspective;
- (b) The proposed site formation and infrastructure have minimal physical impact on the existing heritage sites including Block 7 of The Old Lei Yue Mun Barracks (Declared Monument), Salesian Mission House, Main Building (Grade 2 historic building), and Salesian Mission House, Villa (Grade 2 historic building). These three heritage sites are located outside the project boundary. Structural monitoring during construction stage will be conducted for precautionary and protective measures. Condition survey prior to and after the construction will be provided. The building height of future public housing development will be restricted so as to maintain the visual corridor from the Lei Yue Mun Barracks.
- (c) Cartographic and photographic surveys to properly record the other identified items conducted before and after the alteration works will be provided to AMO for record purpose and future use, such as research, exhibition and educational programmes.
