Archaeological survey-cum-excavation for small house development in Tung Wan, Cheung Chau	Construction of one small house at Tung Wan Site of Archaeological Interest, Cheung Chau	The archaeological works were conducted in early June 2025. Coarse pottery sherds and stone tools dated to Late-Neolithic period were unearthed during the archaeological excavation.
2.	Archaeological survey for small house development in Lin Fa Tei, Yuen Long	Construction of one small house at Lin Fa Tei Site of Archaeological Interest, Yuen Long	The archaeological works were conducted in mid-June 2025. No significant archaeological remains were found in the archaeological survey.
3.	Archaeological survey for small house development in So Kwun Wat, Tuen Mun	Construction of one small house at So Kwun Wat Site of Archaeological Interest, Tuen Mun	The archaeological works were conducted in early July 2025. A few pieces of ceramic shards dated to Ming-Qing periods were identified during the archaeological excavation.
4.	Archaeological survey-cum-excavation for small house development in Sha Tau Kok, North District	Construction of one small house at Sha Tau Kok San Tsuen Site of Archaeological Interest, North District	The archaeological works were conducted in late July 2025. A few pieces of pottery sherds and some stone tools dated to Bronze Age were unearthed during the archaeological excavation.
