| 1. | Archaeological survey for two small house developments in Wun Yiu, Tai Po | Construction of two small houses at Wun Yiu Site of Archaeological Interest, Tai Po | The archaeological survey was conducted between December 2025 and January 2026. Ceramic shards and building features dated to Qing to modern period were found. |
| 2. | Archaeological survey for a small house development in Che Ha, Tai Po | Construction of one small house at Che Ha Site of Archaeological Interest, Tai Po | The archaeological survey was conducted between January and February 2026. A prehistoric broken stone adze was found in the modern layer of test pit. |
| 3. | Archaeological survey for three small house developments in So Kwun Wat, Tuen Mun | Construction of three small houses at So Kwun Wat Site of Archaeological Interest, Tuen Mun | The archaeological survey was conducted in February 2026. Cermaic shards dated to Qing period were found. |
