**Subject:** Ancient SuperVolcano in HK -government news on on 30 August, 2012 - the related "Kowloon Grantie" and government hill buildings, -study missed out in the original consultants' report

Dear Hon Chan, 古諮會主席陳智思先生,

I have submitted a report to AMO before 30 August 2012 on government hill values. However on 30 August 2012, the Ancient Super Volcano in HK was confirmed by government news. I have now updated the report to include a preliminary note [ see pages 27, 28 of <http://icee.hku.hk/activities/HKU100exhibition/doc/20110316g-101/KPC.pdf> ] on the value of the large amount of non-staining granite used in government hill construction, [ identified by Prof Davies of HKU in 1950s ], linked to the Ancient Super Volcano, , the "Kowloon Granite" , from Diamond Hill, as told by Michael Wright in his youtube video interview <http://www.youtube.com/watch?v=ONTaeQMZPUg> .

Identified Ancient high-quality super volcano granite is imparts special meaning for government buildings, signifying the government is building on Rocks of long lasting and foundations as firm as Ancient age of Ancient super volcano. Please note the extent of non-staining granite used in government hill district : the walls on buildings, and the paths, hill retaining wall, from East Block along Garden Road, to Central Block, and to the West Wing, all as ONE PIECE INTEGRAL DESIGN, not to be partly knocked, otherwise losing the great integral value. As far as I know, the government hill buildings, as a group of buildings, used the largeest amount of such high quality granite in HKSAR, as the CITY CENTRE BUILT EXHIBIT of "Kowloon Granite" , linked to the Ancient Super Volcano in HK , [one of the world 50 Ancient Super Volcanoes ] , part of which forms the World Geological Park of Sai Kung.

Since this "Kowloon Granite"-founded-framed-supported government hill construction integrity. and Ancient Volcano Issue were not studied by the original consultant on West Wing and other government hill buildings, may I recommend to you and the government to invite the original consultant to study this issue, and update the report for consideration by AMO and the government. It is premature to jump to a conclusion on the final rating of the government hill buildings, without adding this RECOMMENDED study into the consultant's scope study, and with the updated report then to be presented for consideration by all parties concerned.
